WHAT WILL BE COVERED IN THIS COURSE:

Adobe Illustrator is a vector drawing program used to draw digital illustrations, cartoons, diagrams, typography, infographics, logos and more. The Fundamentals course explores various fundamental tools, functions and techniques involved in generating vector artwork.

The Adobe Photoshop interface can be used as a digital workflow solution in most visual communication projects. The Fundamentals course serves as an introduction to the Photoshop interface and covers essential tools and workflows commonly used in both photographic and design practices. The course also introduces students to using the smart objects functions and filters while learning about file types and file preparation for output.

Adobe InDesign is a powerful desktop publishing software application used to create works such as posters, flyers, brochures, magazines, newspapers, books and even digital publications. The Fundamentals course serves as an introduction to basic tools and techniques used in the application for arranging content in a layout within the software. Attendees will get the opportunity to learn about professional printing and exporting requirements that are specific to various layout outputs.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THIS COURSE?

This course is ideal for anyone who would like to learn basic design and image editing skills in industry preferred and related software. Professionals that work alongside creatives or together with creative teams will benefit from this course.

If you are already skilled in Adobe Illustrator, InDesign and Photoshop but would like to learn more advanced skills, rather enquire about our intermediate and advanced programmes, as this course will only focus on the fundamentals of the software.
